



## **Kratos Awarded \$18.0 Million in Contracts to Provide High Power Amplifiers and Support for Specialized Medical Systems**

The initial award has an approximate value of more than \$6.0 million. Additionally, Kratos has also received an award for service and maintenance of the high power amplifiers to be provided with a minimum value of \$12 million and a period of performance through 2022.

The high power microwave amplifiers to be delivered will be manufactured at Kratos' Herley Lancaster facility and are a critical element of these specialized oncology therapy systems. Initial deliveries of the equipment are expected to begin during the third quarter of this year.
